This Sunday 14th June: A True & Better Abraham

Reading: Genesis 12:1-8

Questions for this week:

- 1. Describe a situation in which you, or someone close to you, has been told, "Go from your country and your kindred and your father's house to a land that I will show you" (Gen. 12:1). What regrets do we human beings have at those times? What apprehensions about the future? What hopes?
- 2. Does the Bible's picture of Abraham, as profoundly faithful in one moment and fearfully self-centred in the next, describe you in any way? When have you alternated between faithfulness and fear?
- 3. Charles Spurgeon said, 'there is a scarlet thread throughout the Bible that leads to a hill called Calvary.' Do you agree? If yes, why? In what ways do you see the scarlet thread from Abraham to Jesus?
