Safety Notice

We're working hard to ensure our church building is clean and safe. Physical distancing and hygiene guidelines will be observed at all times. Hand sanitiser is always available to use during and after your visit. In line with Government legislation, you will need to wear a face mask while in the church building and you should wear it on arrival.

St Mark's Privacy Notice

In line with guidance issued by the Department for Health and Social Care, we will keep your booking details safely and in compliance with GDPR legislation for 21 days before securely disposing of or deleting them. We will only share your details with NHS Test and Trace, if asked, in the event that it is needed to help stop the spread of coronavirus. We will not use your details for any other purposes or pass them on to anyone else.

Worship services held in church are public events, which will also be live streamed and recorded for public viewing. While the camera will **not** be focused on the congregation, your booking is confirmation that you are in agreement with this broadcasting and online viewing, in the unlikely event that you are 'caught on camera'. Care will be taken to ensure that children and adults at risk are not picked up by camera.
