All services will also be live streamed on our Facebook Page.





- God's Church Pastor Ramesh Bumbariya and his family were attacked in their home in Rajasthan state, India, by radical Hindu nationalists. - UN Environment Programme As Pakistan prepares to host World Environment Day on June 5th, ecosystem restoration, which includes critical ecosystems like mangrove forests, will be the focus. Mr Qureshi, Pakistan's so called Father of the Mangroves, who sadly passed away in December 2020, played a key role in the development of mangrove restoration in Pakistan and will be fondly remembered at the event. Mangroves are also a central part of the Pakistan government's ambitious 'Ten Billion Tree Tsunami' drive. Led by Prime Minister Imran Khan and supported by UNEP, Pakistan has committed to planting 10 billion trees by 2023.
